CHAPTER IV

HUMAN RIGHTS

Section 27 - Slavery, servitude and forced labour

- (1) No person shall be held in slavery or servitude.
- (2) Slavery and the slave trade are prohibited.
- (3) No person shall be subject to forced labour.
- (4) No person shall be subject to tied labour that amounts to servitude.
